Adobe Acrobat Intro

◆ Description

- System for producing cross-platform hyper-linked publications.

◆ Components

- **Distiller**

Program for converting files from postscript to pdf, (Portable Document Format), file formats.

- **Exchange**

Program for annotating, creating hyper-links, and adding security control to PDF files.

- **Reader**


Program for viewing, navigating and possibly printing (depending upon security settings) pdf documents.

◆ Macintosh Version 2.0





Acrobat Reader Windows Install

- FILE: acroread.exe

Creates the Adobe Acrobat Windows Program Group.

Acrobat Reader Macintosh Install


◆ FTP

- FILE: **ACROREAD.MAC.bin** ← **Self Extracting Archive**

Decompresses the Adobe Acrobat Reader & supporting files.




Creates the Adobe Acrobat Folder.
